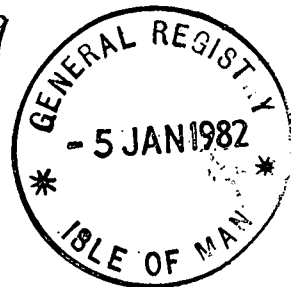

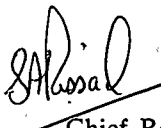

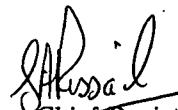

5. I LEAVE AND BEQUEATH to Freda Taggart of Phildraw Ballasalla the sum of FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS (£500) absolutely
